

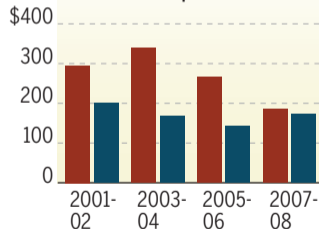
Big Three PACs Went With the Times

The Big Three automakers have had trouble adjusting to market trends, such as relying too long on gas-guzzling SUVs, but Detroit did change course rapidly with its political

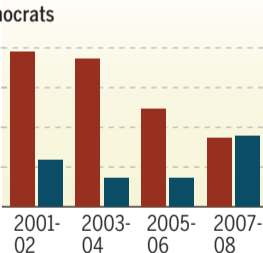
giving once Democrats won control of Congress in 2006. For this election, their political action committee donations were split evenly between the parties.

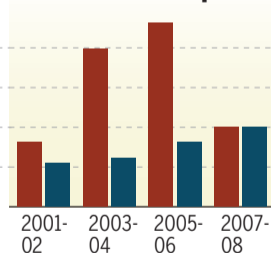
